### Interventions

**Overview:** provision of TA time to deliver intervention programmes to support children

**Aim/outcomes:**

To accelerate rates of progress in reading, writing and maths across all year groups.

### Early birds Writers Programme

**Overview:** Intervention program to help those children who need to make accelerated progress in Writing.

**Aim/outcomes:** Increased progress in Writing and increased self-confidence. Pupils are able to access all areas of the curriculum.
