
1.5.20 Circle Challenge

This one will keep me (Mrs Rolfe) and Mrs Halley happy!


An art challenge with some mathematical links!

Robert Delaunay, an abstract artist from the early 1900's made some wonderful paintings known for their rhythm and colour.


This challenge uses his style of creating many concentric circles and splitting just a few in half (maths bit!). It leaves the page with a pattern (maths bit!) of circles and half circles, which you can colour and highlight with your choices of colours. You can use paint, crayons, pens. 1. Fill the page with circles of all sizes.



3. Split some circles in half with a ruler.



2. Draw concentric circles inside each.



4. Trace and color or paint.
