Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy New Year to our school community! We hope that you had a peaceful Christmas holiday. It was lovely to see everyone this week. The children had the opportunity to wish everyone a "Happy New Year" in assembly on Friday where we focused on making New Year's Intentions - small steps - rather than 'resolutions'. This follows on from our work on kindness and random acts of kindness! This term we will also be discussing the changes that happen in our lives - the planned and unexpected. This is especially important as we move towards the amalgamation of the 2 schools and choosing a new name. Assemblies and PSCHE activities will discuss both the excitement of change and how to deal with worries about change. We will link this to resilience and how it's good to share our worries.

<u>Parental Engagement Workshops</u> - We will be holding a number of parental engagement workshops across both Lyndhurst and Chesswood school sites, giving the opportunity for parents/carers to have their say and contribute to the amalgamation process for the new primary school. There is no need to book a place on one of these sessions.

<u>Singing Lessons</u> - RRS Music Management and Vocal Coaching are offering 1:1 singing lessons during school hours on Mondays, and group sessions during school hours on Tuesdays. If your child is continuing with lessons or has been offered a place, lessons will begin on Monday 8th January (1:1) or Tuesday 9th January (groups). There are still limited spaces available for the Spring term. The 1:1 sessions cost £15 for half an hour session. Group sessions of 3-4 children cost £7 for half an hour. When booking your child's hot meal through ParentPay, please <u>do not</u> book a "Chartwells Trip Lunch" instead of a hot lunch. This is only an option if your child is out of school on a school trip and does not mean that your child will get a packed lunch provided at school.

Some parent/carers are ordering lunches through ParentPay but then sending their child into school with a packed lunch. Please refrain from doing this as it results in food wastage and also incurs a cost to the school, as we have to pay for unwanted meals.

<u>Children Starting School in September 2024</u> - If you have, or know of anyone with, a child due to start school in September 2024, online applications are now open. Due to the planned amalgamation of Lyndhurst Infant School & SSC and Chesswood Junior School, we have been advised by Admissions that for the new school you would need to select 'Worthing New Primary School (to be sited on Chesswood Road)'. The deadline for applications is Monday 15th January 2024.

They then proceeded to 'trek to The Arctic' in 'blizzard' conditions! After taking their 'flight', they completed activities such as 'ice breaker', 'climbing icebergs', and spotting 'Arctic wildlife'. Afterwards the children warmed up with a nice hot chocolate.
