When booking your child's hot meal through ParentPay, please <u>do not</u> book a "Chartwells Trip Lunch" instead of a hot lunch. This is only an option if your child is out of school on a school trip and does not mean that your child will get a packed lunch provided at school.

Some parent/carers are ordering lunches through ParentPay but then sending their child into school with a packed lunch. Please refrain from doing this as it results in food wastage and also incurs a cost to the school, as we have to pay for unwanted meals.

<u>Children Starting School in September 2024</u> - If you have, or know of anyone with, a child due to start school in September 2024, online applications are now open. Due to the planned amalgamation of Lyndhurst Infant School & SSC and Chesswood Junior School, we have been advised by Admissions that for the new school you would need to select 'Worthing New Primary School (to be sited on Chesswood Road)'. The deadline for applications is **Monday 15th January 2024**.

<u>Real Heroes</u> - This term, as part of our topic 'Do All Heroes Wear Capes?' we will be learning about the real heroes in our community.
