<u>Half Term Reading Challenge</u> - We have received some amazing 'Reading Rivers' from lots of the children, showing the journey of all the different types of reading that they came across during half term. Reception

<u>Junk Modelling</u> - This half term, we will be making a castle for Jack and the Beanstalk from junk modelling. <u>Forest School</u> - You should have received a letter advising that the Reception children will have weekly forest school sessions with Mrs Eales this half term on a Friday. The children do not need to wear school uniform on these days, but will need appropriate outside warm/waterproof clothing. They will need wellington boots or shoes/boots you do not mind getting dirty because we will work outside in all weathers.

<u>Street Dance</u> - This half term, the Reception children will have P.E. lessons on a Thursday, run by Kerry from Wannado Street Dance. The children had a great first lesson this week and thoroughly enjoyed it. Please ensure that children come to school on Thursdays in P.E. kit with suitable footwear.

Year 1

<u>New Topic</u> - This half term, Year 1 have begun their new topic; "What Can We Learn About The Great Outdoors?". In Science the children will be finding out about trees and plants, and in Geography they will be learning about maps, as well as human and physical features in our local environment.

<u>St George's Church Visit</u> - As part of the RE curriculum, the Year 1 children will be going on an educational visit to enhance their learning about Christianity. On Wednesday 20th March the Year 1 children will be visiting St George's church to learn more about the features of a church and how Christians worship. You should have received a letter by email yesterday giving more details of this trip. If you have not done so already, please ensure that you give permission for this trip <u>AS SOON AS POSSIBLE</u> as your child will be unable to take part without it. You can do this by logging into MCAS and going to TRIPS > AVAILABLE TRIPS to give your online consent. Alternatively, you can obtain a hard copy permission form from your child's class teacher or the school office.

<u>Phonics & Reading Meeting</u> - You should have received a letter advising that on Wednesday 6th March we are inviting all Year 1 parents/carers to a phonics and reading meeting in the school hall at <u>either</u> 9:00am or 2:15pm. The meeting will last approximately 45 mins. We will explain how we teach phonics and reading at Lyndhurst and provide you with ideas to support your child with their reading at home. We will also explain what the 'Phonics Screener' is and what the expectations for your child will be in the Summer term. There will be an opportunity to ask questions

but we ask you to return the slip on the bottom of the letter so we can ensure all enquires are answered within the session.

<u>Homework</u> - Maths & Phonics homework tasks were due to handed in yesterday. New tasks will be sent home today in homework books and these are due to be handed in by Thursday 7^{th} March.

Mosque Visit - As part of the RE curriculum, the Year 2 children will be going on an educational visit to our local Mosque on Wednesday 28th February. This is a wonderful opportunity for them to learn more about the features of a Mosque and to enhance their learning about Islam.
