<u>Autism Awareness & Mayor's Charities</u> - At Lyndhurst we are fortunate to have a Special Support Centre for children with Autism. The children in Bumblebee Class have the most amazing talents and skills and we would like to celebrate this on Friday 19th April as part of World Autism Day. All children are invited to come into school wearing colourful items of clothing as the theme for this year is colour. Autism affects 1 in every 100 children. It is a lifelong, developmental disability that affects how a child communicates with and relates to other people, and how they experience the world around them.
